**WHAT:** í morning of fun working with reading, writing, math and arts and craftsí .scienceí cookingí dramaí an afternoon of swimming, hiking, sports, and adventures There is a full day field trip each week. The Site Coordinator will send a calendar of events, welcome letter and the permission slip in May. A bus route will be sent out in mid-June.

**COST:** \$26.00 per day however help is available:

- You can apply for and use the **Vermont State Child Care Assistance Program** to assist with these fees by calling [773-4365](tel:773-4365) for the necessary forms. Families usually qualify if parents are working, going to school or receiving training. There are income guide lines;
  - A family of four can gross \$3,674 per month and still receive 10% help with the fees
  - A family of four can gross as much as \$2,920 and receive 50% help with fees
  - A family of four can gross \$1,837 and receive 100% help with fees
- Call the Tapestry Office at [786-1935](tel:786-1935) to request a sliding scale or scholarship form if you are denied by the Child Care Assistance Program
- If you are paying, you will receive a payment coupon to send in with the payments every Friday.
- All summer costs can be applied as a Child Care Credit on your tax return when filing because the program is a licensed site and has a tax identification number
- There is an enrollment fee of \$25.00, which is not applied towards payments

**HOW TO ENROLL:** Use the attached student form to enroll your child. **You can send the check made out to "Rutland Public Schools" with the Enrollment Form in an envelope to the secretary at your child's school.** The form will be given to the Site Coordinator who sends the forms on to this office. The deadline will be **by April 8<sup>th</sup>**. Current students who have been enrolled during the school year have first option. The remaining spaces are filled until the school has reached the quota of 80 students. You will know that your enrollment form has reached this office when you receive the financial letter with coupons.

**STAFFING:** Most of the personnel who work in the Tapestry Summer Camps are also employed by the school district. The program maintains an adult for every 10 children. The level of professional development of the staff is very high. The philosophy, rules and guidelines that apply during the school year apply during the summer as well. Ms. Marchese will be Site Coordinator.
